DAY 2 Da Nang-Hoi An-Da Nang

After breakfast, visit Danang Cathedral, which is a Gothic-style pink church in the city. It was built in 1923 by the French. Nowadays, it has become the Catholic cathedral which serves thousands of followers. Later, proceed to Son Tra Mountain. En route, you will see the famous Han River and the spectacular Dragon Bridge. Upon the arrival of Son Tra Mt, overlook the bay of Da Nang and East Sea. Marble Mountains, a collection of five outcrops topped with atmospheric pagodas, is a rewarding day trip from Da Nang. Later, visit Cam Kim Island, which is known for its traditional crafts and lifestyle. Taste the seafood meal for lunch. After lunch, visit Hoi An, a well-preserved Ancient Town, in Vietnam. This ancient city is noted since 1999 as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Tourists can fully experience the city by strolling along the streets and tasting the Vietnamese snacks.
